### **BASIC BOATING SAFETY (TSBC)**

This course builds on the skills learned in Piloting (prerequisite). It teaches positioning techniques, advancing a line of position. Electronics: radar, depth sounders, autopilots, chart plotters, laptop computer software. Hazard avoidance using electronics. Collision avoidance using radar and GPS. Working with tides: clearances, depth, effects of current. Piloting with wind and currents. "Seaman's Eye" - skills for checking that one is on course.
